Farewell to Richard

Richard Newman has been a long time supporter of School Sport. He was known as Mr Primary Football having been involved as SAPSASA's football coach since 1979. He also had a short stint as manager of the SSSSA Representative Football team in 1992. He was awarded life membership of SAPSASA and earned both a School Sport Australia Service Award and School Sport Australia National Honour Award for his involvement in Primary Football at the National level.



Richard epitomised the philosophy of School Sport - fairness, honesty and integrity. When coaching or managing, students in his care experienced friendliness, fun, enjoyment and a sense of achievement. Richard treated all competitors equally regardless of their skills and abilities. He spent numerous hours working out equal playing time for all players and informing them prior to a game what quarters they would be on or off the field. His record number of wins espouses the value of this concept.

Junior Sports Policies always recognise the benefits of providing the opportunity for all young people to engage in sport in a way that brings them satisfaction, good health, fun, recognition and provides valuable learning outcomes. Richard has been doing this all his life, long before any Junior Sport Policy existed.

Richard became part of the School Sport Unit team when he won the position of SAPSASA Manager in 2002. Aside from his involvement in Football, Richard approached the position of Manager of SAPSASA and delegate to School Sport Australia with dedication and commitment.

During this time, he developed a sense of community and family with each of the teams he worked with. Richard established an atmosphere around these teams which ensured that everyone was included and had a voice. There was never any shortage of volunteers as parents/friends were happy to be involved in any program or project that Richard led. His primary focus was always on the needs of the students ensuring

that all programs offered by both SAPSASA and SSA provided them with positive and quality experiences that would encourage ongoing participation.

In the many years that Richard worked for SAPSASA, he became an asset to schools, the School Sport Unit and School Sport Australia. His expertise and enthusiasm has been invaluable and he has been an outstanding mentor for hundreds of school students. He is a true friend of all in the School Sport Unit and he will be sadly missed.
